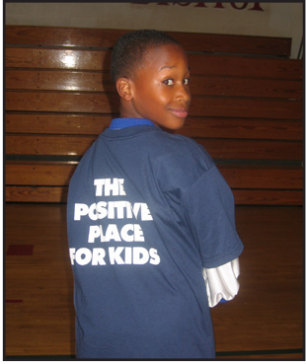

Who We Serve

BGCI serves children ages 5-18.

BGCI served nearly 12,000 youth in 2006

- 7,869 members
- 3,952 other youth served

Gender Breakdown

- 58% male
- 42% female

Racial Breakdown

- 51% African American
- 35% Caucasian
- 7% Hispanic
- 7% Other (Native American, Asian, Multi-Racial)

Income

- 90% of our members have household incomes under \$30,000.

Membership

A Club membership is only \$10 per year, however it costs Boys & Girls Clubs \$421 annually to provide services for each child.

Impact

The Facts

- 67% of our members report doing better in school because of the Club.
- 86% of our members said that Club programs assist them in resisting tobacco.
- 84 cents of every dollar raised goes directly to providing services for our youth.
- In a parent survey, 94% say that the Club is “a safe place for kids.”
- In 2006, Club members increased by one grade level in both math and reading.
